- In 2008, Glasgow was named the UK's first City of Music and only the third city in the entire world to be awarded this accolade
- Over half a million people enjoy gigs in our iconic venues every year
- The city hosts around 130 events per week* - more than any other Scottish city, with everything from contemporary and classical, to Celtic and Country. These events include traditional music sessions, rock gigs, classical music concerts and experimental electronica.
- We have 8 venues in the Top 100 list of places to watch gigs outside of London
- The OVO Hydro, is ranked in the top five best global arenas, above the likes of Madison Square Garden




