Dr Marita Fraser is head of Sculpture and Environmental Art at Glasgow School of Art. She is an artist, a writer and a researcher exhibiting and performing internationally, including projects with Kunsthaus Vienna, Städtisches Museum Engen, Atelierhaus Salzamt Linz and Perth Institute of Contemporary Art. As an artist she works across sculpture, installation, painting, performance, art writing, moving image and scores. Her research interests include 'speaking with' as a feminist method of practice, the legacies of Carla Lonzi, Carolee Schneemn and Margaret Macdonald Mackintosh, and methods of feminist refusal as creative practice. In 2017 she was awarded the ArtReview Casa Wabi Residency Award.

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Abstract

Speaking With (2020–23) is a film which explores entangled spaces of feminist thinking and writing, responding to the work of Italian Feminist Carla Lonzi (1931–82) and Ukrainian-born Brazilian novelist Clarice Lispector (1920–77), alongside material practices of textiles, sound and movement, through moving image practice. Speaking With examines the spaces between the artist and her school run asking where does friendship sit within material based and
