## IS AGROECOLOGY THE ANSWER?



Agroecology involves an ecosystem-based approach, or "farming with nature." That's what Kurie explains to the smallholder farmers she trains through her business Sylvie's Basket. Growing up in Nairobi, holidays spent at her grandparents' farm sparked her dream of becoming a farmer.

But the organic and regenerative practices that have replenished her soils were not necessarily passed down through the family.

In the past, she says, they were told that the "Green Revolution" - the title given to the introduction of industrial agriculture - was going to feed Africa. So far, it hasn't delivered.

## 10 Simple Ways to Improve Your Health

- 1. Enjoy de-stressing**  
Experts recommend regular exercise, meditation and breathing techniques to reduce stress. But even something as simple — and enjoyable — as listening to soothing music, reading a good book, looking at a hot tub or playing with your pet can help you relax.
- 2. Put away the salt**  
A saltshaker on the dining table makes it all too easy to consume excess salt, which can lead to high blood pressure. So put the shaker in a cabinet or pantry and bring it out only when you're cooking.
- 3. Get to bed earlier**  
Most of us don't get the seven or more hours of sleep adults need. Over time, a shortage of shut-eye can raise your risk of a heart attack or stroke — regardless of your age, weight or exercise habits. If you're consistently sleep-deprived, going to bed even 15 minutes earlier every night could help. Also set a regular sleep and wake schedule, and stick to it — even on days off.
- 4. Have a glass of red wine**  
Studies have shown that the powerful antioxidants found in red wine protect against heart disease, colon cancer, osteoporosis and depression. So unless there is a medical reason why you shouldn't imbibe, go ahead and enjoy that glass of merlot with your nightly meal — you can even toast to your good health.
- 5. Check your posture and ergonomics**  
Next time you're at your desk or on the phone, take a moment to think about your posture. Straighten up your back, tuck in your stomach and put your feet flat on the floor with your legs uncrossed. You'll feel more relaxed right away.
- 6. Do a crossword puzzle**  
Researchers at Rush have found that mentally challenging activities, such as reading, doing crossword puzzles or Sudoku and playing chess, may have a protective effect on your brain.
- 7. Weigh in**  
Maintaining a healthy weight can lower your risk for heart disease, stroke and some types of cancer. And for women, there's another reason to keep pounds from piling on: It will decrease the risk for future pelvic floor disorders.
- 8. Make a few dietary substitutions**  
Swap white bread, rice, crackers and pasta for healthier whole grain versions. Use skinned chicken and turkey in your recipes instead of skin-on, and lean out of other meats such as beef or pork. Replace one sugary drink (soda, juice, etc.) each day with a full glass of water.
- 9. Take the stairs**  
The next time you're going to a higher floor, bypass the elevator and climb the stairs instead. You'll get your blood pumping, exercise your lungs and work the muscles in your lower body.
- 10. Stretch it out**  
Respiratory stretching your muscles helps you avoid injuries, stay limber and move freely as you age. Take a few minutes to stretch out before and after you exercise. If you aren't working out but still take a few stretch breaks. Find a quiet space in the office where you won't be disturbed. Or the gym? Look for natural overabundances in your daily routine to stretch, such as getting out of your car or reaching for items on a high shelf at the store.

### The Return of the Wilds -

Unused and industrial agricultural land has been reclaimed and heavily rewilded. Where barley fields once dominated the landscape, now thick forests live. Roaming herd animals and predatory mammals have returned to the ecosystem after a long absence. Owning pets is illegal. For a human to work with an animal, animals must enter a contract with a set duration and guaranteed rights. Advances in science have made this communication easier, although still not a perfect science. Because of this, feral cats and dogs have re-entered the ecosystem. This has led to the return of species such as lynx and wolves.

### Migration Corridor -

The main travel corridor that remains in use, passing through the main regions of London, Manpool (Manchester - Liverpool super district) & Glasburgh (Edinburgh - Glasgow super district)

### Wandering Homes -

Prohibitive rent prices in hyper-dense cities have pushed people to remote living. Caravans of travellers have formed to migrate through the British wilderness, working together to provide communal energy through renewables and food through hunting and mobile hydroponics. These caravans have their own isolated trade economies, with remote workers in the caravans interacting with the larger global economy as a whole.

### Metropolis -

Cities are now hyper-dense structures, with several generations living under the same roof. Inhabited by the working elderly and the non-able-bodied, they are centres of technological development, sustained by hyper-dense local vertical farms, lab-grown meat and the trade of passing caravans.

### Global Trade -

De-carbonising sea trade has been one of the biggest challenges of the last decade. Humanity has returned to sail-powered ships, utilising the latest in cutting-edge materials and weather prediction. Consequently, global trade is more
